God loves you and your family and friends.

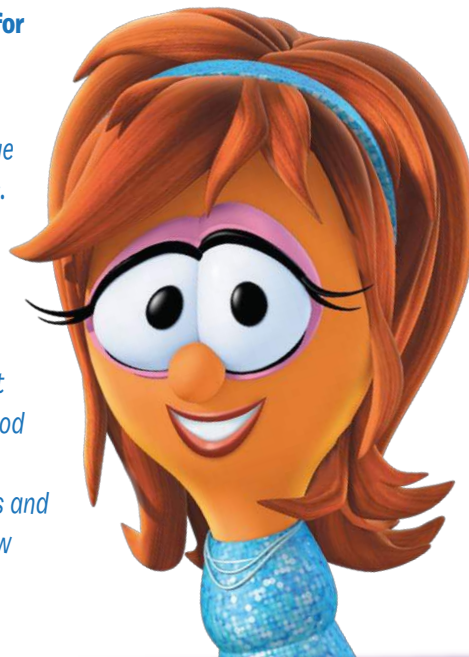
**4 Did Mr. Beet change right away, or did it take some time for Mirabelle’s kindness to soften him?**

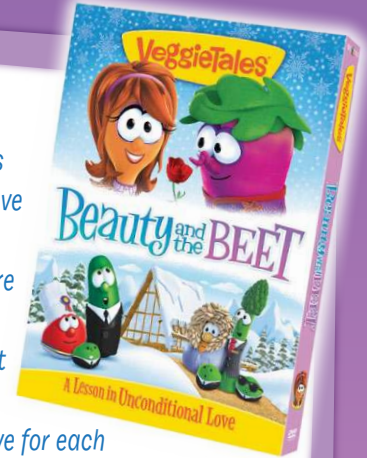
**6 How can we show God’s love to people who are unkind to us, even if others don’t understand?**
