

# 25 Bible Verses for Kids

## GOD SAVES US

1

**John 3:16-17:** For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.

**Isaiah 40:11:** He will tend his flock like a shepherd; he will gather the lambs in his arms; He will carry them in his bosom, and gently lead those that are with young.

3

**Romans 3:23:** For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

4

**Romans 6:23:** For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

5

**Romans 8:1:** There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

6

**Romans 10:13:** For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.

7

**Acts 4:12:** And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

8

**Colossians 2:13-14:** And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses, by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This he set aside, nailing it to the cross.

# 25 Bible Verses for Kids

## KNOW GOD

9

**Psalm 103:8, 10-12:** The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities. For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him; as far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us.

**Psalm 33:4:** For the word of the Lord is upright, and all his work is done in faithfulness.

11

**2 Peter 3:9:** The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.

12

**Revelation 21:3-4:** And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away."

13

**1 John 4:8:** Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love.

14

**Psalm 145:9:** The Lord is good to all, and his mercy is over all that he has made.

15

**1 John 1:5:** This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

16

**Proverbs 30:5:** Every word of God proves true; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him.

## LIVE WELL

17

**Matthew 22:37-39:** And he said to him, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.

**Ephesians 4:32:** Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.

19

**Psalms 119:9:** How can a young man keep his way pure? By guarding it according to your word.

20

**Psalms 119:105:** Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

21

**Matthew 6:14-15:** For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you, but if you do not forgive others their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

22

**Psalms 150:6:** Let everything that has breath praise the Lord! Praise the Lord!

23

**Proverbs 3:5-6:** Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.

24

**Ephesians 6:1:** Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. “Honor your father and mother” [this is the first commandment with a promise], “that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land.”

25

**Philippians 4:8:** Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.
