Go

- 1 Cut out the card along solid lines and fold on dotted line.
- 2 Color in everything outlined in blue.
- 3 Cut out the leaves and flower (below). Cut between petals.
- 4 Glue flower over the green circle on the front of the card.
- 5 Glue a colorful button in the center and gently fold the petals forward.
- 6 Fold each leaf on dotted line and glue half of it to the green outlines on the card front, letting the other half fold forward.
- 7 Color the inside and be sure to sign your name with hugs and kisses.

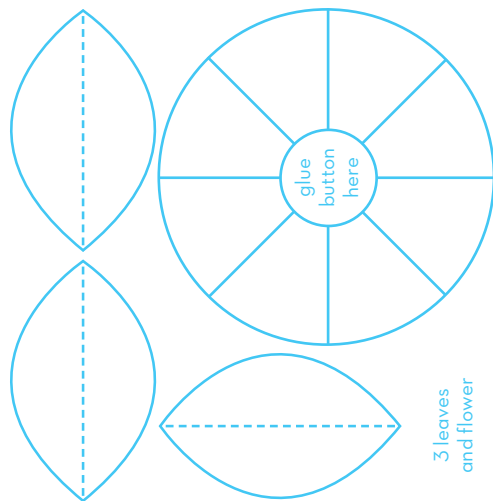
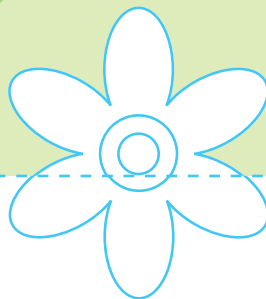
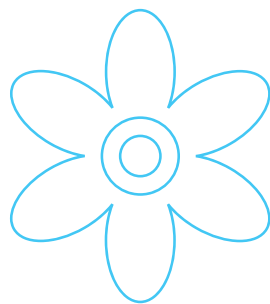
