Option Ultrasound grew out of a desire to help expectant mothers choose life for their babies. Since this program was launched in 2004, we estimate that more than 472,000 little ones have been spared from abortion!

In 2019, "Alive from New York" featured inspiring speakers, powerful music, and a live ultrasound on giant, digital screens in Times Square. More than 20,000 people packed into Times Square for that event with tremendous feedback!

A similar event was held last year in virtual form, and this year a series of six pro-life videos on a weekly basis started in July. Then, on August 28, the live See Life 2021 event in Dallas culminated our See Life 2021 campaign. Once again, the positive stories poured in. The Lord is moving in hearts and changing minds to impress upon people the beauty and sanctity of life in the womb.
