

Letter of Instruction To Guardians and Trustees



In order to assist the Guardian of my minor children and the Trustee(s) of any trust share created for my children under my living trust, I leave these specific instructions to provide guidance in understanding our desires.

The Trustee(s) determined in their absolute discretion that the beneficiary or his parents are unable to afford such costs. My Trustee(s) may, in its sole and absolute discretion, make exceptions to this condition when my child has been injured, ill, or suffered other disruptive circumstances. Study Abroad Programs: If financially feasible, all or any part of my children's college education may be taken in a university located in a foreign country. _ I would especially encourage a university in the following countries: ________ Four-Year Incentive: I direct my Trustee(s) to make a special distribution of \$______ to a child that completes his/her undergraduate degree from an accredited college or university within FOUR (4) years or less. Family: To the extent that distance will allow, it is very important to me that my children shall have equal contact with members

□ Travel: Before my minor children can travel alone, the Trustee(s) is directed to pay for either the Guardian or another family
member to meet the traveling child and accompany the child to the travel destination.
☐ Holidays: Holidays are important to our family and for that reason, my children are to spend some time with our families on
holidays (Thanksgiving, religious holidays and birthdays). It is my desire that an acceptable arrangement be worked out between all families concerned.

Payment: As compensation, on each anniversary of the date my children began living with their Guardian, my Trustee(s), upon the written request of such Guardian, shall pay to such Guardian as compensation for caring for my children an amount not to exceed \$
This annual compensation shall continue until my youngest child reaches the age of or completes his or her high school education, whichever occurs first.
Such compensation shall be paid from the net income of the trust and under no circumstances shall my Trustee(s) invade
the trust principal to pay such Guardian's compensation. In the event the trust net income for any year shall not equal the
amount of compensation requested by the Guardian, the Guardian's compensation for that year shall be the amount of trust net income in that anniversary year.
☐ Vacation: As compensation for caring for my children, my Trustee(s) may make an annual distribution for any expenses incurred
by the Guardian for a vacation enjoyed by both the Guardian's family and my children.

Ministry Work: The Trustee(s) shall annually provide \$_____ (increased by the Consumer Price Index) to each beneficiary who is then a full-time employee in a Christian organization as defined in Exhibit "A" attached to this letter of instruction. _ Alternative: The Trustee(s) shall match _____% of any beneficiaries' earned income from working in the Christian ministry. Missionary Work: In my Trustee(s)' sole and absolute discretion, I authorize them to provide the financial support necessary for any of my children to work as a full-time missionary with a Christian missionary organization (as defined in Exhibit "A" attached to

this letter of instruction).

Automobiles: If the Guardian or my Trustee(s) decide to give any of my children an automobile or assist any of my children in the purchase of an automobile, such automobile must be considered "reliable and safe" according to automobile analyst sources, such as "Consumer Reports" magazine or other such publication. ☐ Driving Safety: The Trustee(s) shall annually provide \$_____ (increased by the Consumer Price Index) to each descendant who is then under age _____, has a permanent driver's license for at least 12 months and has received no driving violations in the prior calendar year. Firearms: My children are not to be permitted to own or use firearms of any kind. Business Start-Up (continued) Business Plan Approval Requirement: Prior to my Trustee(s) distributing any Trust funds to assist my child(ren) to start or purchase a business or professional practice, my child(ren) shall first submit a business plan to the following individuals ("Business Advisors") and obtain their approval of said plan: Any determination made by these Business Advisors shall be final, binding and controlling if made with a majority/unanimous (strike one) agreement and evidenced by a written statement stating such opinion delivered to the Trustee(s) of the child's separate Trust share. If any of the forenamed Business Advisors is unable or unwilling to make such a determination, the Business Advisors shall make such determination so long as there is a minimum of three (3) individuals involved. If any of the Business Advisors is unable or unwilling to make such a determination, such Business Advisor may appoint a successor individual to serve in his place; the remaining Business Advisors shall unanimously appoint a successor individual to serve with them as Business Advisor. The individuals appointed to serve as Business Advisors shall in no way be responsible or liable for actual performance of profitability of my child(ren)'s proposed business venture. Counseling Grief Counseling: Due to the impressionable age of my children, I caution my Trustee(s) and Guardian to be vigilant in observing signs of distress or difficulty in coping with the situation after my death. I specifically authorize my Trustee(s) to provide for Christian-based grief and/or psychological counseling for any of my children that my Trustee(s) and Guardian determine are in need of such counseling. Self-Esteem Counseling: While in early adolescence, my children are to take assertiveness training classes in order to build strong self-esteem. ☐ Budgeting Instruction: I believe that budgeting is an important step to responsible financial management. When my children reach age ____, they are to each take budgeting lessons or courses. Prior to establishing a separate trust share for any of my children, my Trustee(s) shall recommend a budget counselor for each child to consult and shall encourage each child to receive budget counseling. Despite any conflicting provisions in my revocable living trust, I direct that prior to receiving any income or principal from the separate trust share created for them under my Trust, each of my children shall consult with a budget counselor approved by my Trustee(s). If my child creates and lives within the bounds of his/her budget for _____ consecutive days, then my Trustee(s) may distribute any income and principal to the child from his/her trust share in accordance with the terms and conditions of my

revocable living trust.

 My Trustee(s) may rely on the written statement of the budget counselor that after creation of the budget, my child lived within its bounds for consecutive days. My Trustee(s), in its sole discretion, is authorized, but not directed, to pay any costs associated with the budget counseling process.
Financial Counseling
Allowances: I leave the following instruction to the Guardian and Trustee(s) regarding an allowance for my child(ren):
Budgeting Instruction: I believe that budgeting is an important step to responsible financial management. When my child reaches age, they are to each take a Christian-based financial budgeting course such as Crown Financial or Dave Ramsay's Financial Peace University. Despite any conflicting provisions in my trust, I direct that prior to receiving any income or principal from the separate trust share created for my children under my trust, each of my child(ren) shall complete a course in financial stewardship from a Christian, biblically-based financial teaching ministry such as Crown Financial or Dave Ramsay's Financial Peace University. My Trustee(s) in its sole discretion, is authorized, but not directed, to pay any costs associated with the budget counseling process.
Matching Earned Income: Once my child reaches age, the Trustee(s) shall distribute to the child an amount equal to% of the earned W-2 income of such child as reported on the child's federal income tax return.
Financial Investment Instruction: It is my strong belief that financial education is critical to my child(ren)'s ability to make optimal use of inherited funds. To this end, in all matters concerning the investment of funds distributed to my child(ren), it is my desire that: When my child(ren) reach the age, they each are to take financial planning courses. My child(ren) should consult regularly with a financial advisor regarding investment matters.
I have worked with the following financial professional and request my child(ren) to initially consult with this individual:
Debt Avoidance: It is my strong desire that my children avoid the dangers of consumer debt. As such, each year my child provides the Trustee(s) with a credit report indicating such child has no debt, I direct the Trustee(s) to make the following distributions as an expression of my appreciation for their careful financial stewardship: An amount reasonable and necessary to pay for such child's family to enjoy a family vacation, not to exceed \$, as adjusted for inflation based upon the Consumer Price Index.
