- <u>Attitude</u>—Don't see the glass as half-empty. Keep a positive attitude, like that of Christ. **Philippians 2:5** Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus.
- <u>Name above all names</u>—Put Christ first in our lives, modeling Christianity for others around us. **1 Peter 2:9** But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.
