### Behind the Times (pp. 8-9)



- 1 Did you ever avoid a friend who hurt you? What happened? Are you still friends?
- 2 Your safety matters. What's a good way to extend forgiveness to a mean person without putting yourself in danger?

3 Ephesians 4:26 warns, "Don't let the sun go down on your anger." What does that mean? Is it possible to work through intense feelings that quickly?

### Hoppy to Help (p. 23)



- 1 What animal do you think would make the best pet?
- 2 Would you rather hold a bunny at a celebration or on a sad day?
- 3 If you ask God to "open my eyes," what do you think He'll show you?

**Parents,** Did you spot the prayer on page 22? Talk about what it means for Jesus to be your Savior.

### The Inventor's Secret (pp. 24-27)

- 1 Garrett hid his identity as an inventor. Was that a good or bad idea?
- 2 What would've happened if Garrett waited for folks to apologize *before* he showed grace and helped them?
- 3 "We all get the same grace." Is there anyone you can't (or won't) forgive? How does it feel to hear God loves them too?



### Easter Encounter (pp. 28)

- 1 Where would you go in the Imagination Station?
- 2 Why does Mr. Whittaker call the resurrection Jesus' greatest miracle?
- 3 How did Mary feel *before* going to the empty tomb? How did she feel after?
- 4 Who can you tell that Jesus is alive? What's one way you can share the Good News?
