



# DIY MACRAME KEYCHAINS

Make these fun macrame keychains for yourself or a friend. You can clip them to your backpack or purse, or wherever you want, to add personality and cuteness. They're easy and quick crafts, and only require four simple supplies.



# SUPPLIES:

1. 192 INCHES OF 4MM STRING—ANY COLOR

six at 24 inches

one at 48 inches

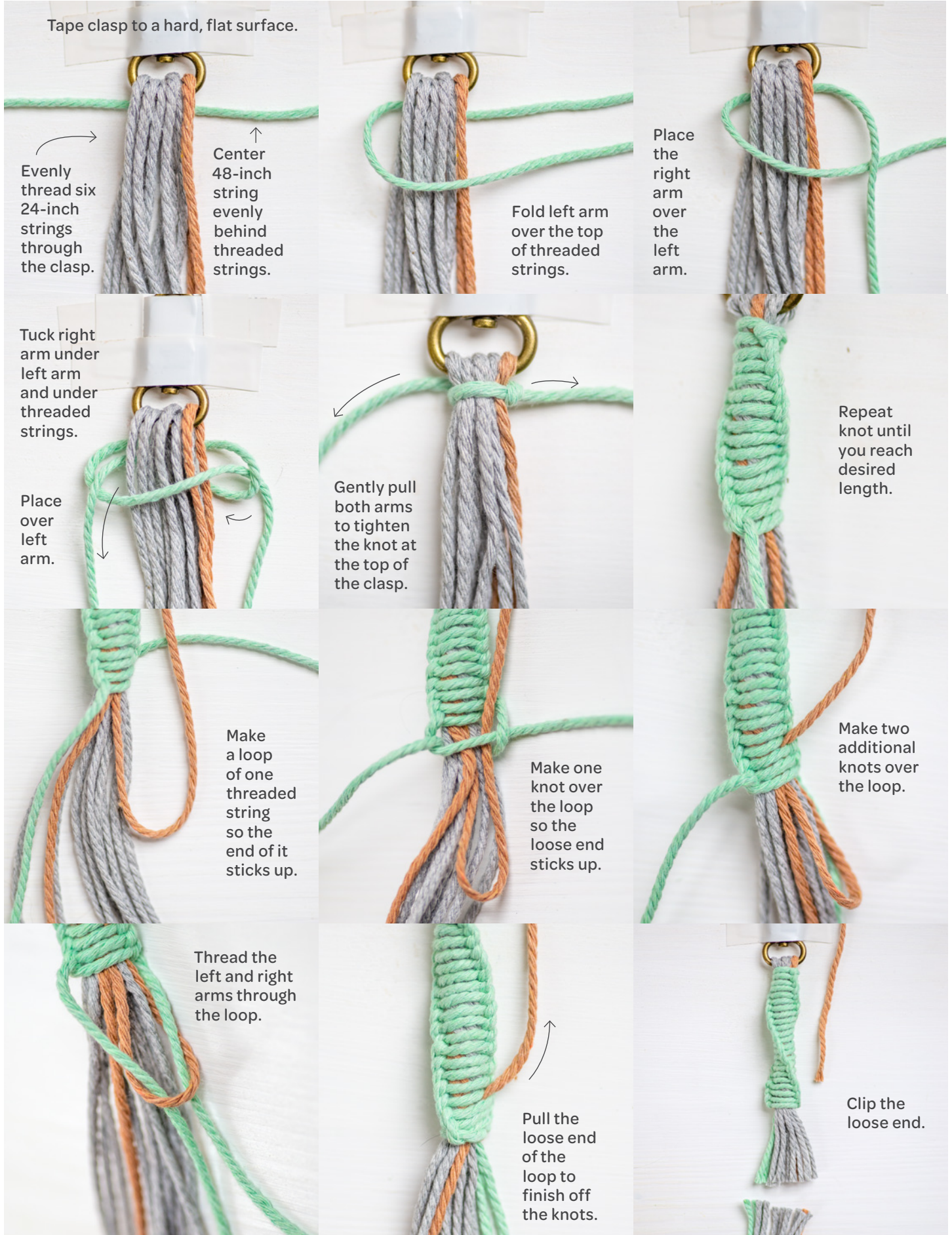
2. CLASP

3. SCISSORS

4. SUPER STICKY TAPE



**DIRECTIONS:** Cut six strings 24 inches long. Cut one string 48 inches long.





**SUPPLIES:**

**DIRECTIONS:** Cut two strings 48 inches long. Cut one string 24 inches long.

**1. 6MM STRING**  
two at 48 inches  
one at 24 inches

**2. CLASP**

**3. SUPER STICKY TAPE**  
**4. SCISSORS**

Take one of the 48 inch strings and fold in half. Then thread it through the clasp.

Thread the tails through the loop.

Pull tight to secure.

Repeat securing the remaining strings. The shorter string should be between the two longer strings.

Tape clasp to a hard, flat surface.

Take the outer strings and separate from the others.

Take the left string and overlap the center strings.

Then loop under the center strings and over itself.

Push up and secure the knot.

Take the right string and overlap the center strings.

Make a loop from one of the long string tails so the end of it sticks up.

Then loop under the center strings and over itself.

Push up and secure knot at the top of clasp.

Repeat to make ten knots on each side for 20 knots total.

Wrap the left string around the loop three times.

Thread the end of the left string through the loop

Pull the loose end of the loop to finish off the knots.

Clip the loop end and lower loose ends.



**SUPPLIES:**

**DIRECTIONS:** Cut six strings 12 inches long. Cut one string 24 inches long.
