FOCUS ON THE FAMILY MONGOLIA'S EXPANDING IMPACT

Ten years ago, Focus on the Family Mongolia started as a quiet presence in one of the most unreligious regions of the world. Today, they're being invited into some of the most unlikely spaces - from the military and government orphanages, to hurting families on the edges of society and even Mongolian churches in the U.S.

Recently, a member of Mongolia's General Authority for Border Protection attended a Date with Dad event - an unfamiliar concept in a culture where fatherhood tends to be more distant and formal. But after seeing the impact of intentional fatherhood firsthand, they reached out and asked: Could Focus Mongolia help restore families across the military?

Soon, the team was traveling to remote military outposts launching low-profile, on-site trainings and Zoom conferences for families. As a result, Focus Mongolia's quiet faith and servant-hearted approach are opening doors where few ministries could go.

This quiet faithfulness was recognized with an honorary medal from the military.

This year, the team also launched a suicide prevention initiative projected to reach over 3,000 people - doubling their prior impact in this space.

That same heart for healing is reaching across oceans. After the International Director's Conference in June, 2025, Focus Mongolia CEO, Dr. Hongoroo and her husband Ganbat stopped in Washington state before making their final trip back to Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia. There they visited a Mongolian church where they've

introduced programs such as No Apologies and Raising **Highly Capable Kids -**

equipping first generation parents and teens navigating the tension between heritage and Western culture.

With growing Mongolian communities in California, Illinois, Colorado, and

New York, these partnerships have powerful potential to support Focus Global's 5x vision: to multiply our global reach fivefold over the next five years.
