Give each person a THANK card. On it, you'll find a few empty squares. Before the game starts, each person can write one thing they're thankful for in each square. Be specific! Then they can write each on a separate caller card, noting the column at the top with a T, H, A, N or K. This will personalize the game and is a great way to get to know each other better.

Choose someone to read the caller cards and then start the game. Every time a caller card is read, put a marker, such as a button, M&M or corn kernel, on the square that matches. When someone gets five squares in a row, that person should call out, "Thank!"
