

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRINTING

If you're able to print at home, here are some helpful steps for printing:

Step 1) Open the PDF in Adobe, your computer's photo viewer, or your chosen internet browser.

Step 2) Locate the PRINT icon or right-click with your mouse and click "Print" from the drop-down menu

Step 3) Update your printer preferences to PRINT IN COLOR.

Step 4)

- a. If your printer can print on both sides of the paper, make sure you update your printer preferences so it will print on both sides (flipping sides on the LONG edge).
- b. If your printer cannot print on both sides of the paper, here are your next steps:
 - i. Print the front side of the cards
 - ii. Retrieve the paper with the front side of the cards, open your paper loading tray, load the front of the cards in so the back of the cards will print on the blank side of your paper (this may be a different process for different printers, so we recommend you do a test print first before printing on cardstock).
 - iii. Go back to your computer and print the back side of the cards.

Step 5) Repeat steps 1 through 4 to print as many sets of these Christmas cards as you'd like!

Step 6) With a parent's help, cut the cards out so they are ready to send in an envelope or hang on your fridge! (Note: You may need to trim off some excess on the side of each card as the cards may not print perfectly aligned front-to-back on some printers)

Step 7) Send to your friends and family or hang up at home to display your Adventures in Odyssey Christmas cards!



Your Adventures in Odyssey Christmas Cards may look best when printed in color and on cardstock. If your printer cannot print in color or on cardstock, we recommend you take this PDF to a local office supply store or print shop where they can print the cards for you. If you're planning to take these to a print shop, you may be required to show proof of permission to print. Please show the printer the note on the following page which gives your family permission to print your Adventures in Odyssey Christmas Cards.

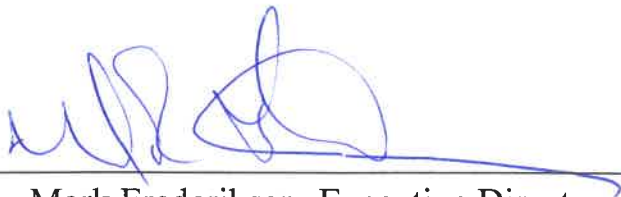

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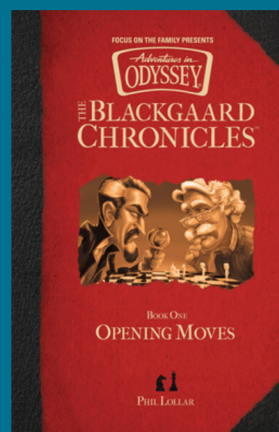

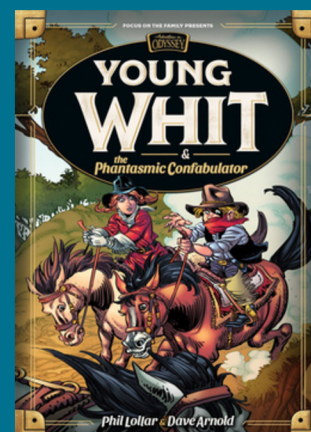
